On Friday, November 30, 2018, two unknown suspects had attended several Scotia bank branches located in the Towns of Newmarket and Sutton. Both suspects had produced fraudulent drivers' licenses and other documentation to withdraw funds from the victim's account. On November 2, 2018, suspect #2 had attempted a similar fraudulent act in Welland, Ontario but was unsuccessful.
