On Saturday, November 5th and again on Sunday, November 27th, 2011 the suspect was captured on surveillance video during night time hours peering in the windows of a residence in the area of the 9th Line and Bur Oak Avenue in the Town of Markham. On each occasion the suspect was captured on video peering in the windows at the side of the home. While at the side of the residence the suspect peers in through two different windows. During one of the incidents the home owner heard a noise outside and yelled at the suspect which then caused him to flee the area.





THE SUSPECT IS DESCRIBED AS:

Male, possibly South Asian, 18 – 25 years of age, approximately 5'8" to 6', 200 – 220 lbs., with a heavy build, with a chin strap beard, wearing black rimmed prescription glasses, a dark coloured track suit with a hood underneath, a zip up jacket with a reflective logo on the left breast of his jacket and another reflective logo on his left upper thigh of his pants.
