On Monday, December 26, 2012, at 3:50 p.m., a female victim was at the Markville Mall, located at 5000 Highway 7 East, when her wallet containing credit and debit cards was stolen from her purse. Upon calling to cancel her cards, the victim learned that a quantity of cash had been removed from her bank accounts.

Investigators have obtained video surveillance of two suspects. The suspects are described as female, Middle Eastern or South Asian, with dark hair. The suspects are believed to have been involved in similar crimes in the Greater Toronto Area since 2010.
